

This Cookie Policy was last updated on August 10, 2023, and applies to citizens and permanent residents of the European Economic Area.

1. Introduction

Our website <https://www.tecumed.com> (hereinafter referred to as the “website”) uses cookies and other related technologies (for convenience, all technologies are referred to as “cookies”). Cookies are also placed by third parties we have engaged. In the document below, we inform you about the use of cookies on our website.

2. What are cookies?

A cookie is a small, simple file that is sent along with the pages of this website and stored by your browser on the hard drive of your computer or other device. The information stored in them may be returned to our servers or the servers of relevant third parties during a subsequent visit.

3. What are scripts?

A script is a piece of program code that ensures our website functions correctly and interactively. This code is executed on our server or on your device.

4. What is a web beacon?

A web beacon (or pixel tag) is a small, invisible piece of text or an image on a website used to track website traffic. For this purpose, various data about you is stored using web beacons.

5. Cookies

5.1 Technical or functional cookies

Some cookies ensure that certain parts of the website function properly and that your user preferences are remembered. By placing functional cookies, we make it easier for you to visit our website. This way, you do not have to repeatedly enter the same information when visiting our website, and, for example, items remain in your shopping cart until you complete your purchase. We may place these cookies without your consent.

5.2 Statistical Cookies

We use statistical cookies to optimize the website for our users. Thanks to these statistical cookies, we gain insight into how our website is used. We ask for your permission to store statistical cookies.

5.3 Marketing/Tracking Cookies

Marketing/tracking cookies are cookies or any other form of local storage used to create user profiles for displaying advertisements or to track a user on this website or across multiple websites for similar marketing purposes.

When you first visit our website, we will display a pop-up window explaining our use of cookies. By clicking "Save Preferences," you consent to the use of the categories of cookies and plugins described in the pop-up window and in this Cookie Policy. You can disable cookies through your browser settings, but please note that our website may no longer function properly.

7.1 Managing Consent Settings

9. Your Rights Regarding Personal Data

- Right of access: You have the right to access your personal data that we hold.
- Right to rectification: You have the right to supplement, correct, delete, or block your personal data at any time.
- If you give us consent to process your data, you have the right to withdraw that consent and have your personal data deleted.
- Right to data portability: You have the right to request all your personal data from the controller and to have it transferred in its entirety to another controller.
- Right to object: You may object to the processing of your data. We will comply with this request unless there are legitimate grounds for processing.
